Award Criteria:

- 2. Applicants must be a junior or senior level student as defined through credit hours at their high schools.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident with a permanent and current passport.

Application Process:

Applicants must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. Two (2) character references in the form of a letter of recommendation.
- 3. A copy of their most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. A copy of the current Student Aid Report [SAR] from Free Application for Federal Student Aid/ [FAFSA].
- 5. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay form. *What service or career path do you plan to pursue and why? [600 words* limit]
- 6. Applicants must agree to a personal interview with the selection committee via phone or Zoom, upon completion of the application.

*T*he application deadline is **January 1, 2025**. Applications postmarked after January 1^{st} will not be considered. No incomplete applications will be considered.

Announcement of Scholarship Recipients: April 1st, 2025

Special Provisions: Scholarship funds will be issued directly to the recipient or their choice of higher learning institution of their choice campus.

Recipients MUST be attending the same higher education institution for two consecutive semesters.
